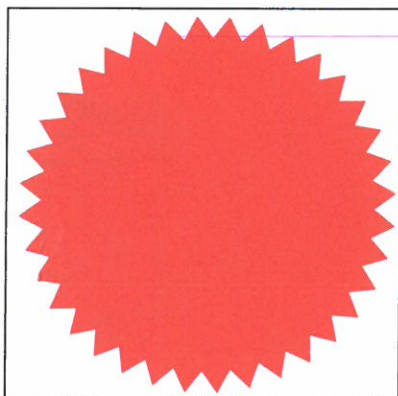
CERTIFICATE OF REPRESENTATIVENESS OF COUNCIL
